3.1 Related News in Telecom Sector

1. The NCB documents for "Scaling up of Public ICT Access Services" were submitted to Board for Decision.
2. The unserved VDCs of Nepal and that of EDR were identified.
3. EoI Evaluation Report for conducting Computer Training to ICT center operators, was submitted to the NTA.
4. Conducted study and submitted proposal on Infrastructure Sharing.
5. Provided Opinions for the import recommendation of Equipments to NDCL, SNPL and other operators.
6. NCB Notice was published, and subsequently conducted pre-bid meetings.
7. The operators and APT were communicated about the SATRC Workshop that NTA is going to host.
8. Monthly progress report on VDC coverage was sent to MoIC.
9. Study was carried out on the setting up of spectrum assignment criteria, review of the existing Spectrum pricing of different telecommunications services for effective and efficient utilization of spectrum of WLL and mobile cellular spectrum. And subsequently Consultation Paper was prepared.
10. Coordination Working Mechanism/Modality between NTA and MOIC regarding the usage of Frequency Monitoring System of MOIC for the monitoring of Spectrum for different Telecommunication Services was prepared.
